Winemaker's Notes

Bacchus is a Riesling x Sylvaner x Mueller-Thurgau cross that produces lively, aromatic wines that are naturally low in alcohol. The variety excels in cool climates and it has thrived on the upper bench of our Suncrest vineyard since it was planted in 1986. Perhaps best known as our most refreshing summer wine, Bacchus also makes a great aperitif wine any time of the year.

Tasting Notes

Fresh, floral, lively citrus and peach aromas. Crisp, off-dry and very flavourful on the palate.
